Resolution # Pool-001, calling for an election by the Town Council of the Town of Ekalaka for the purpose of supporting the maintenance of the existing cultural facilities within the Town of Ekalaka for a period of two fiscal years 2027 and 2028, voted levies will be in excess of the maximum levy as is authorized by MCA. Shall there be a levy for the purpose of maintaining and funding the swimming pool for \$15,000.00 annually for approximately 35.16 mills?

If the mill levy were to pass, the impact of the election on a primary home within the Town of Ekalaka valued at \$100,000.00 would result in additional property taxes of approximately \$26.72 per year, a primary home within the Town of Ekalaka valued at \$300,000.00 would result in additional property taxes of approximately \$80.16 per year, and a primary home valued at \$600,000.00 would result in additional property taxes of approximately \$171.26 per year.

**DAHL MEMORIAL HEALTHCARE SPECIAL LEVY 001  
(VOTE IN ONE OVAL)**

Shall the Board of Carter County Commissioners authorize a special levy, in addition to the levy currently authorized by Section 15-10-402 MCA, the special levy which is approximately 2.87 mills to raise the sum of \$260,000.00 (two hundred sixty thousand) annually for a period of two (2) years, fiscal years 2027 and 2028?

This funding will be used to cover costs related to 24/7 emergency and paramedic services and essential healthcare for residents provided by Dahl Memorial Healthcare Association. Funds will be used for maintaining local hospital operations, staffing, and patient care services, including up to \$15,000.00 (fifteen thousand) annually which will be dedicated to a Community Respite Fund. This fund will provide short-term relief stays and specialized adult day care to provide essential relief for local family caregivers and support for residents who qualify for financial assistance.

If the mill levy were to pass, the impact of the election on a primary home in the county valued at \$100,000.00 would result in additional property taxes of \$2.18 per year; a primary home in the county valued at \$300,000.00 would result in additional property taxes of \$6.54 per year; and a primary home in the county valued at \$600,000.00 would result in additional taxes of \$13.97.
